Insufficient evidence to support hazing charge, however activity was not aligned with the College's practices and commitments. Discussion with all students by program faculty with additional discussion between Program Faculty and Senior College Administration

Name of Subject: Student (Freshman)
Date Subject Charged with Violation: March 2018
General Description of Violation: Anonymous report of hazing of freshman in dormitory
Investigation & Findings: Investigated by Dean of Students and Senior Vice President/Chief of Staff. Insufficient evidence to support hazing charge. Student provided counseling services and per his request was moved to an alternate dormitory. Follow-up activity with student was conducted with no additional issues reported
