- **NEW:** Governor Wolf and Secretary of Health Dr. Levine today extended the orders for all counties in RED (that includes Delaware and surrounding counties) to June 4th and signed new orders for the 24 counties moving them to the YELLOW phase. - **UPDATED:** Governor Wolf signed an executive order today (4/7) that protects Pennsylvanians from foreclosures or evictions through July 10. The action builds on a Pennsylvania Supreme Court order which closed court eviction proceedings until May 11 and ensures no renter or homeowner will be removed from their home for 60 more days. - **NEW:** The PA Office of Advocacy and Reform (OAR), established by Governor Wolf's 2019 executive order announced today the launch of a volunteer think tank comprised of 25 experts representing a diversity of fields and backgrounds. The group will focus on setting guidelines, benchmarks, and goals for trauma-informed care across the commonwealth. In addition, the group is also expanding its original mandate to strategize how to heal the trauma that all Pennsylvanians are experiencing due to the COVID-19 pandemic. - **NEW: PA Pandemic Unemployment Assistance:** Contractors, gig workers, self-employed individuals and other Pennsylvanians who applied for the new Pandemic Unemployment Assistance (PUA) program can file now for weekly benefits. For more information, please see this [LINK](#)
