- **UPDATED:** Governor Wolf and Secretary of Health Dr. Levine today (5/8) extended the orders for all counties in RED (that includes Delaware and surrounding counties) to June 4<sup>th</sup>. **On May 15<sup>th</sup>, 13 additional counties will move to YELLOW.** See the map for the 37 total state YELLOW counties, effective May 15<sup>th</sup>. - **UPDATED: Delaware County:** Delaware County Council announced today that additional COVID-19 testing sites, including a mobile unit testing site, are being added in Delaware County. These additional options expand diagnostic testing access for residents whether or not they have health insurance. ### **Additional Government Announcements:**

- **NEW:** In order to limit the number of people who must visit PennDOT Photo License Centers, the department announced that they will use existing photos on file to renew driver licenses and photo ID cards. All customers who renew their driver’s license or photo ID card online or through the mail will receive a new product using the most recent photo of that individual that exists in PennDOT’s system. Individuals who completed a renewal form prior to May 10 will still receive a camera card in the mail and will need to have an updated photo taken. For more information, please see this [LINK](#)
